



Faith Plans is going to Stockholm+50

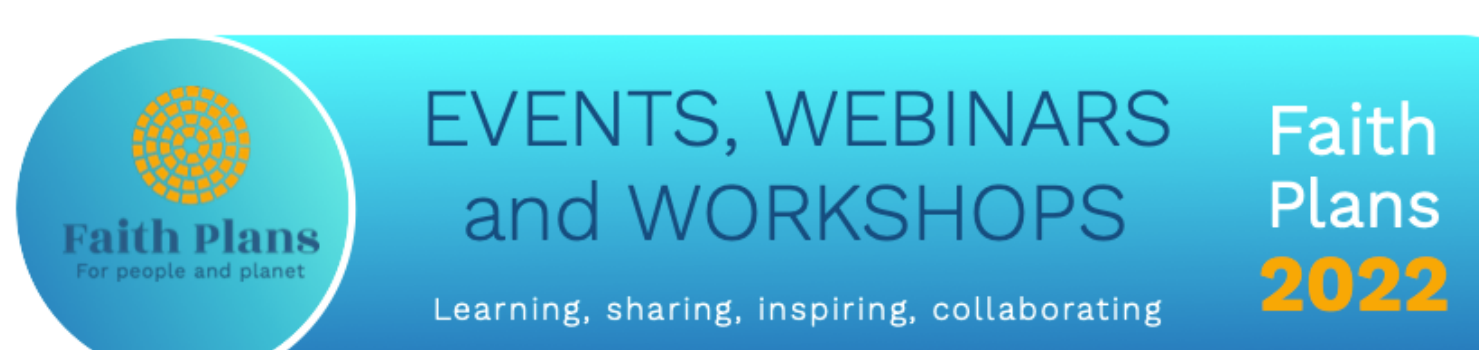
On June 2 and 3, the Faith Plans team will participate in a crucial, international high-level meeting in Stockholm, Sweden. Dubbed 'Stockholm+50', because it marks the 50th anniversary of the United Nations Environment Programme, it has the working title of 'a healthy planet for the prosperity of all - our responsibility, our opportunity'. This is an opportunity for the international community, including the faith community, to commit to ensuring planetary stability, and turning those commitments into decisive action.

Faith Plans will join our partners and other civil society organisations in Stockholm, to highlight and celebrate the commitment and contribution of faith communities as key stakeholders in the future of the planet. We will use this opportunity to show how faiths are already leading the way during this crucial decade of transformation.

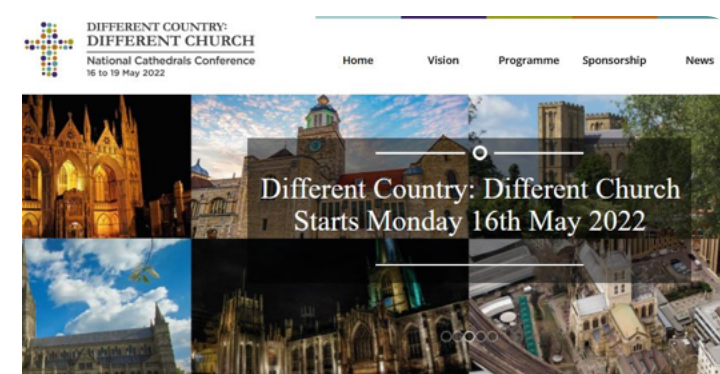
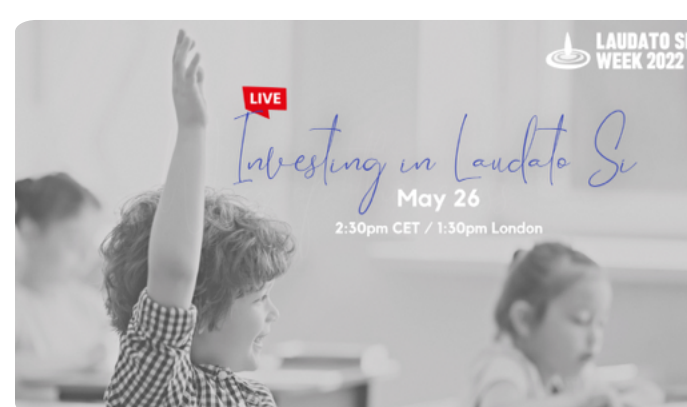


Greening Friday 2022
