Faith Plans update: January 2022



Welcome to the first Faith Plans update of 2022

Last year ended on a sense of urgency, thanks to the COP26 climate conference, which saw faith communities represented as never before. So you won't be surprised to hear that, for us, 2022 will be all about action. And, in particular, the Faith Plans programme offers a timely opportunity for faith communities to say how they will tackle the ecological crisis within this decade – join us!

Urgency and action were a key feature of our Faiths Rising webinar on December 16, when people representing faith traditions from all around the world <u>gathered online</u> to hear how faiths are acting on climate change and environmental destruction.

Moderator **Gopal Patel of Bhumi Global** emphasised the role of faith as a motivating factor to drive action. Faiths of all traditions were now putting their values front and centre in leading on genuine and positive change for a safe and secure future, he said.

FaithInvest's Dr Lorna Gold cited recent evidence of worsening climate impacts to communicate the urgency for action. **Allen Ottaro of CYNESA** explained how it is crucial that their engagement with young people on environmental action addresses other social and economic problems, and **Rev Susan Hendershot of Interfaith Power and Light** echoed the consensus of the gathering – faiths are moved into action because of their beliefs and values. Finally, Lorna outlined the next steps for the Faith Plans programme.
